Petitioner is aggrieved by the order dated 5.6.2015 (Annexure P-4) passed by the Deputy Director, Urban Local Bodies, Ludhiana, wherein it has been observed that in case the petitioner fails to fulfil the conditions as envisaged in the license, same would be cancelled and it would be proceeded against under the provisions of PAPRA Act, 1995.

Admittedly, the petitioner has preferred an appeal against the said order before the appellate authority. Alternative prayer is for expeditious disposal of the appeal which has been pending since the year 2015.

Petition is disposed of with a direction that in case the appeal filed by the petitioner is still pending, the same be decided expeditiously in any case not later than four months.

In case any coercive action is sought to be initiated against the petitioner, it shall be at liberty to move an application before the appellate authority which shall be heard forthwith.
