The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 read with Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of interim bail for a period of one week to attend the marriage of his brother and sister, which is fixed for 17.01.2020/18.01.2020 in case FIR No.170 dated 22.06.2019 registered under Sections 120-B, 148, 149, 302, 307, 323, 324 and 326 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Siwani, District Bhiwani.

Learned State Counsel has appeared and opposed the bail application.

I have heard learned Counsel for the petitioner and learned State Counsel and gone through the record.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the marriages of brother and sister of the petitioner are scheduled for 17th and 18th of January, 2020. Father of the petitioner is old aged person suffering from heart disease and there is no other male member in the

family to meet the necessary arrangements. In view of the festivity involved and also elder members of the family being essential for performance of customary rites, the petitioner may be granted interim bail for the period of one week.

On the other hand, learned State Counsel has argued that the petitioner along with his co-accused murdered Lilu Ram and caused injuries to Kaptan. The petitioner inflicted 'Danda' blow on the head of deceased-Lilu Ram. The petitioner does not deserve grant of interim bail and the petition may be dismissed.

Keeping in view the facts, nature of accusation against the petitioner and the role attributed to him but without commenting on merits, I am of the considered view that the petitioner does not deserve grant of interim bail for attending the said marriage. Therefore the petition is dismissed.
