RAMENDRA JAIN, J. (Oral)

Through instant petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. prayer has been made for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in a case arising from FIR No.196 dated 28.07.2019, registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, at Police Station South, Sector 34, Chandigarh.

According to prosecution, petitioner and his co-accused Ravi Bhatia, duped the complainant for Rs.40,000/- on the pretext of arranging his visa.

On instructions from Sub Inspector Vijay Kumar, learned counsel for respondent-UT, Chandigarh has consented to the submissions of learned counsel for petitioner that main co-accused Ravi Bhatia has been enlarged on regular bail by the Coordinate

Bench vide order dated 13.09.2019 in CRM-M-38232-2019.

Considering overall facts and circumstances, but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, treating the case of the petitioner on the same parity as that of his above co-accused, the petition is allowed. Consequently, petitioner Dinesh Kumar Sehgal is ordered to be released on bail during pendency of trial, if not required in any other case, on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
