This is second petition for grant of pre-arrest bail. First petition was dismissed on 19.12.2019 while passing the following order:-

“Petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in FIR No.171 dated 23.8.2018 registered under Section 21 of the NDPS Act at Police Station Adampur, Jalandhar Rural.

On 17.9.2019 taking note of the contentions of the petitioner, following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner could not appear before the trial Court on 14.8.2019 as he was admitted in De-addiction Centre.

Notice of motion for 24.9.2019.

In the meantime, the petitioner

would appear before the trial Court. On appearance, he would be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing bonds subject to the satisfaction of the Court concerned.

Copy of the order be produced on the next date of hearing.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner very fairly admits that the petitioner has not appeared before the Trial Court even after the indulgence was granted on 17.9.2019.

In view thereof, this Court is not inclined to grant concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.”

Keeping in view the conduct of the petitioner, no ground to grant pre-arrest bail is made out.

Hence, dismissed.
