Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 86 dated 26.12.2019 registered under Sections 353, 186, 148 and 506 IPC at Police Station Talwara, District Hoshiarpur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has been made victim by the hospital authorities with a view to save themselves in connivance with the police and has got registered the FIR especially when they were at fault.

On instructions from ASI Rakesh Kumar, learned State counsel has pointed out that the petitioner has refused to give blood samples for medical purpose and it has been observed by the Doctor that he was drunk at that time.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

It is ordered that the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so, in the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on bail to the satisfaction of Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
