Prayer in this application is for preponement of the date of hearing in the main case.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the date of hearing in the main case is preponed from 17.07.2020 to today itself and the same is taken up for consideration.

Application stands disposed off.

CRM-M-2294-2020:

The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail in case FIR No.422 dated 17.10.2018, under Sections 420, 379 and 120-B of the I.P.C. and Section 66-C of the I.T. Act, registered at Police Station Manimajra, Chandigarh.

[2]. The petitioner was arrested on 11.12.2019. He has already remained in detention for exactly 8 months by now. In the meantime, investigation against him has already been completed and challan submitted.

[3]. In such circumstances, further detention of the petitioner for an indefinite period, at this stage, is not warranted.

[4]. In view of the above, the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned, who shall, however, impose appropriate stringent conditions in its discretion to preclude absconsion of the petitioner, considering that he is otherwise a resident of the State of Tamil Nadu.
