The first petition, bearing CRM-M-48921-2017, filed by the petitioner with the same prayer, was dismissed for non-prosecution on 17.05.2018 by a coordinate Bench of this Court by passing the following order:

“Even on second call, no one has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner. 2. Time was granted to the petitioner as a last opportunity on 26.02.2018. Before that also the matter had been got adjourned by the petitioner right since its filing in December, 2017. 3. Dismissed for non-prosecution.”

A perusal of the head note of the present petition shows that the present petition is not referred to as 'second petition'.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as not maintainable since the petitioner has a remedy to revive the first petition.
