Petitioner is seeking quashing of the order dated 24.05.2018 (Annexure P-5), whereby his case for promotion to the post of TGT (Punjabi) has been rejected on the ground that he is not possessing the qualifications of B.Ed..

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is JBT. He has got two year diploma in Elementary Education (ETT). He states that as per judgment dated 12.09.2018 passed by this Court in **Suresh Chander and others vs. State of Haryana and others**, CWP No.12143 of 2016 (Annexure P-8), petitioner should have been promoted to the post of TGT (Punjabi). Learned counsel further refers to the order dated 30.08.2019 (Annexure P-9 Colly.), whereby pursuant to the judgment passed by this Court in **Suresh Chander's** case (supra), benefit of promotion has been granted to all the JBTs, who have got the qualification of BEIED.

Petitioner has served a legal notice dated 25.11.2019 (Annexure P-7) upon the respondents claiming promotion at par with other employees, who have been promoted vide order dated 30.08.2019

(Annexure P-9).

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Kiran Pal Singh, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

At this stage, present petition is disposed of by giving direction to respondent No.2 to look into the legal notice dated 25.11.2019 (Annexure P-7) and pass appropriate order in accordance with law, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
