[1] Claim in the writ petition is for the issuance of a writ, order or direction in the nature of mandamus for directing the official respondents to release salary of the petitioners, who are working as Shift Attendants with respondent No.2 w.e.f. October, 2019, till date.

[2] Learned counsel states that the petitioners have already submitted a representation before the competent authority in respect of the grievance, which is the subject matter of the writ petition, though the same has not been attached along with the present writ petition and that in the circumstances, the petitioners would be satisfied, if the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation, in accordance with law, in a time bound manner.

[3] Without commenting upon the merits of the claim or the entitlement of the petitioners to the relief claimed, the writ petition is ***disposed of*** by granting liberty to the petitioners to submit a copy of the representation claimed to have already been submitted to respondent No.2 for grant of the relief

prayed for in the writ petition within a period of 01 week from today. On receipt of the representation, respondent No.2 would consider and decide the same within a period of 02 weeks thereafter, in accordance with law, after taking into account all aspects of the matter.
