The petitioner earlier filed a writ petition before this Court seeking pensionary benefits but the same was disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the representation of the petitioner. The petitioner however, filed COCP-1863-2016, which was disposed of vide order dated 16.2.2018 by observing as under:-

“Upon notice replies have been filed. Along with the replies the statutory forms seeking revised pension are shown to have been forwarded in October 2016 and thereafter the benefits of revised retiral benefits released in November 2016. It is conceded that even the interest upon the delayed release of ACP grades was paid. Although the petitioner was guilty of delay in claiming the same. It is not the claim of the petitioner that the payment of the original retiral benefits were delayed, however, it is only after the claim of the grant of ACP grade pay, the claim for revised retiral benefits had accrued and there does appear to be some reasonable delay in releasing the revised amount.

In the facts of the case, this Court finds no case for continuing the present contempt proceedings, however, the petitioner would be free to pursue the matter with the department.

Accordingly, the present contempt petition is disposed of in the above terms.”

The petitioner seems to have been once again approached to the concerned authorities vide Annexure P-8.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner states that she will be satisfied, if a direction is issued to decide the representation of the petitioner.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the concerned respondent to decide the representation (Annexure P-8) as expeditiously as possible preferably within three months of the receipt of the certified copy of this order and pass a speaking order.
