Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he be permitted to withdraw the present petition granting him liberty to raise all the pleas before the trial Court. He further submits that since the petitioners/accused are residents of Gujarat, it would be difficult for them to appear in the trial Court on each and every date of hearing and they be allowed to be represented through counsel.

Permission to withdraw the petition is granted.

The trial Court is directed to exempt the personal appearance of the petitioners/accused, allowing them to be represented by counsel duly authorized obtaining an undertaking from the counsel in that regard. However, it is made clear that the petitioners/accused would put in appearance before the trial Court, if the trial Court feel their personal appearance to be necessary for any reason.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
