In pursuance of order dated 16.01.2020, the learned State counsel has verified about marriage ceremonies.

In terms of order dated 09.01.2020 passed by Additional Sessions Judge, Jind, it was directed that the applicant-accused be taken in police escort on 20.01.2020 from District Jail, Jind to Hansi, District Hisar from 07:00 am and be brought back to District Jail Jind at 05:00 pm so that he can attend some ceremonies of the marriage of his real niece (Bhanji), namely, Pooja. It has further been directed that the applicant-accused be not left free at any stage during that time.

It has been further contended that the marriage is to be performed during night and some ceremonies, in which the presence of the petitioner is required, are to be performed prior to the reception of *barat*.

The learned trial Court has been fair enough in permitting the petitioner to attend some of the ceremonies and facilitate his presence at the venue during the day hours of 20.01.2020. During that period, any ceremony in which the presence of the petitioner is required can be solemnized.

In view of the above, no ground to interfere in the present case is made out.

Dismissed.
