Petitioners claim that they have attained majority and married against the wishes of their family members. Apprehending threat to their life and liberty, they have filed the present petition for protection.

Petitioners claim to have submitted a representation (Annexure P-5) dated 15.01.2020 in this regard, to the Superintendent of Police, Yamunagar.

Heard. Record perused.

Notice of motion to the office of Advocate General, Haryana.

On asking of the Court, Mr.Munish Sharma, AAG, Haryana, present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State. Copy supplied.

Petitioners have placed on record copies of their Aadhar Cards (Annexures P-1 and P-2) as proof of their age as well as copy of marriage certificate (Annexure P-3) and two photograph (Anexure P-4) on one sheet

regarding performance of marriage. Learned counsel for the petitioners has also placed on record a copy of Certificate of Secondary Examination of petitioner No.1 during the course of proceedings.

This petition is disposed of with a direction to the Superintendent of Police, Yamunagar, to look into the representation Annexure P-5 dated 15.01.2020 and ensure that no harm is caused to the petitioners.

However, it is made clear that this order shall not be treated as stamp of the Court about the marriage of the parties and no opinion regarding the validity of the marriage has been expressed.
