Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.196 dated 24.11.2019, registered at Police Station City Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur, under Sections 323, 324, 34 and 326 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that there is a delay of 03 days in registration of the FIR. The alleged occurrence took place on 21.11.2019 whereas the FIR was got registered on 24.11.2019. He further contends that the petitioner had been allegedly armed with iron rod and given simple injuries, which constitutes an offence under Section 323 IPC only.

On the other hand, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Somlal, opposes the prayer made in the present petition. The learned State counsel states that challan is yet to be presented.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioner has been in custody since 24.12.2019. The trial of the case would take time to conclude. Therefore, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars.

In view of the above, without commenting anything on the merits, lest it should prejudice the case of either side, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
