The writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to renew the passport of the petitioner, after taking into consideration representation dated 16.11.2019 (Annexure P-1), in case there is no legal impediment. In any case, the representation aforementioned be decided by

passing a speaking order after grant of opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
