Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.127 dated 27.11.2018 registered under Sections 406, 498-A of IPC at Police Station Women, Patiala, District Patiala.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Baljinder Singh, states that recovery of one ring and two *karas*, as per the bill dated 03.01.2018 for an amount of Rs.1,74,812/-, is to be effected from the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners have already deposited Rs.90,000/- with the I.O. and the petitioners undertake to deposit the remaining amount of Rs.84,000/- with the I.O. for

the alleged recovery of remaining gold items, however, that be made subject to the outcome of trial.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioners have joined the investigation but as per the State counsel some recovery of some gold is yet to be effected.

Accordingly, in case the petitioners deposit a sum of Rs.84,000/- with the Investigating Officer within 2 weeks from today, the order dated 05.02.2019 shall become absolute.

With the above direction, the present petition is disposed of.
