Petitioners claim that they have attained majority and married against the wishes of their family members. Apprehending threat to their life and liberty, they have filed the present petition for protection.

Petitioners claim to have submitted a representation (Annexure P-4) dated 16.1.2020 in this regard to the Superintendent of Police, Palwal.

Notice of motion to the office of Advocate General, Haryana

On asking of the Court, Mr. Munish Sharma, AAG, Haryana, present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State. Copy supplied.

The petitioner No.1 has placed on record copy of Aadhar Card (Annexure P-1) and petitioner No.2 has placed on record copy of his driving license (Annexure P-2) as proof of their age.

Copy of receipt of Nikah from Kazi (Annexure P-3) regarding performance of Nikah is also placed on record.

This petition is disposed of with a direction to the Superintendent of Police, Palwal-respondent No.2, to look into the representation Annexure P-4 dated 16.1.2020 and ensure that no harm is caused to the petitioners.

However, it is made clear that this order shall not be treated as stamp of the Court about the marriage of the parties and no opinion regarding the validity of the marriage has been expressed.
