B.S.WALIA, J. (Oral)

1. Prayer in the petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for the issuance of a writ of Mandamus for directing the respondents to promote the petitioner as Leading Fireman and thereafter as Sub Fire Officer as per Haryana Municipal Service 'Integration Recruitment and Conditions of Service' Rules, 1982. Learned counsel contends that the petitioner has submitted representation Annexure P/8 dated 25.09.2019, in respect of the grievance which is the subject matter of the writ petition, but the same has not been decided till date and that in the circumstances, the petitioner would be satisfied if the writ petition is disposed of at this stage by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation Annexure P/8 dated 25.09.2019, in accordance with law, in a time bound manner.

2. Notice of motion to respondent No.2 only. Mr. Harish Rathee, Sr. DAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.2, waives service and states that he has no objection to the limited prayer of learned counsel for the petitioner.

3. Without commenting upon the merits of the controversy or the entitlement of the petitioner to the relief claimed, the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation Annexure P/8 dated 25.09.2019, in accordance with law, after taking into account all aspects of the matter, as expeditiously as possible preferably within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
