The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 CrPC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.155 dated 21.08.2018 under Section 22 of the NDPS Act registered at Police Station Lehra, District Sangrur.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the case and he has not committed any offence, as alleged in the FIR.

Learned State counsel has apprised this Court that the petitioner was admitted on interim bail awaiting the outcome of FSL report, but during this period also, he was found involved in another case under the NDPS Act i.e. FIR No.82 dated 08.04.2019 under Section 22 NDPS Act, PS Lehra. Moreover, there are five more cases registered against the petitioner under the Excise Act.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that the petitioner is involved in many other cases including one case under the NDPS Act, no case for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made out.

Dismissed.
