The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 31 dated 03.5.2014 registered at Police Station Harike, District Tarn Taran under Sections 307, 323, 324, 326, 379, 382, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act, 1959.

Learned counsel for the petitioner state that though the petitioner has been named in the FIR but no specific role has been attributed to him and the injury attributed to the petition in the head is simple in nature. He has pointed out that co-accused namely Sukhwinder Singh, Kuldeep Singh, Dilbagh Singh, Avtar Singh @ Jagtar Singh, have been granted the concession of regular bail by this Court. The petitioner has been in custody since 18.11.2019.

In the present case, the dispute is regarding the Govt. land and the FIR has been registered against 37 accused.

Learned State counsel does not dispute this factual position.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties. The petitioner has been in custody since 18.11.2019, no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner behind the bars.

In view of the above, without commenting anything on the merits, lest it should prejudice the case of either side, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
