Learned State counsel seeks to place on record a short affidavit.

Prayer is accepted. Affidavit is taken on record. Paras 3 and 4 thereof read as under:-

“3. That in this regard, the Respondent No.1 has already initiated the communication with Tehsildar, Mohali vide letter Memo No. LAC/Acq/Mohali/185/1320-A dated 19.02.2020 for the deletion of entries made in view of the notification No. LAC/Acq/157-2-B dated 02.01.2006 and No. LAC/Acq/164/695-B dated 12/13.02.2006 to acquire the land under section 4 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 as the said notification has automatically lapsed on account of non-completion of the process of acquisition of land.

4. That in view of the steps taken by the Respondent No.1 and issuance of instructions to the revenue department for deletion of entries, the grievance of the petitioner has been addressed and now the petition has become infructuous and may kindly be disposed of accordingly.”

In view of above, no cause of action survives. Writ petition is disposed of.
