A reply by way of affidavit of the Tehsildar-cum-Sub Registrar, Nawanshahr, District Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar, has been filed in Court today. The same is taken on record and a copy has been furnished to counsel opposite.

Challenge in the instant petition is to a notice/order dated 23.09.2019 vide which petitioner had been called upon to deposit an amount of Rs.3,55,000/- towards deficient stamp duty pertaining to a sale-deed bearing No.4080 registered on 04.12.2007.

In the affidavit filed on behalf of the State today in Court it has been categorically averred that the impugned notice dated 23.09.2019 (Annexure P-2) already stands withdrawn on 27.01.2020.

In view of the above writ petition is disposed of as infructuous.

It would however be open for the respondents to proceed in the matter in accordance with law.
