This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.763 dated 30.08.2018, under Section 135 of the Electricity Act, 2003 registered at Police Station, APT, District Jalandhar.

On 18.01.2019, notice of motion was issued in this case and the benefit of interim pre-arrest bail was extended to the petitioner.

On 03.04.2019, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner shall clear the entire dues within two months from that date and requested for a short adjournment. The case was adjourned to 15.07.2019 and on said date, the learned counsel submitted that the petitioner shall make arrangement for payment of ₹ 1.5 lacs within a period of one month and the matter was adjourned to 25.09.2019 and 27.01.2020.

Today also, learned counsel has sought time for depositing the dues. Since the orders dated 03.04.2019, 15.07.2019 and 25.09.2019 have not been complied with as the petitioner failed to clear the dues, he is not entitled for concession of pre-arrest bail. Resultantly, the petition is dismissed.
