In the present case, the complainant-Kashmir Kaur, in her complaint received by post, alleged that on 03.01.2020 at 3.00 PM, 4/5 police officials in civil dress had taken her son Lakhwinder Singh @ Lakha along with them without any reason and there is an apprehension that her son may be implicated in some false case.

Reply by way of affidavit of Jashandeep Singh Gill, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police (South), Ludhiana has been filed by the learned State Counsel in Court today. The same is taken on record.

As per the reply, FIR No. 6 dated 03.01.2020 under Section 21 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, at Police Station Dugri, Ludhiana, has been registered on a secret information, against Lakhwinder Singh @ Lakha-son of the applicant/petitioner and 6 grams of Heroin has been recovered from him. It has also been mentioned in the report that the son of the petitioner is a habitual offender and is involved in many cases.

In view of these facts, no further orders are called for in the present petition. The same is dismissed, accordingly.
