Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 119 dated 01.08.2019 registered under Sections 325, 323 and 34 IPC and Section 308 IPC added later on, at Police Station Sadar Faridkot, District Faridkot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the injured-Gursewak Singh was a Conductor with a bus bearing registration No. PB-13L-7107 and on 18.07.2019 in the bus itself an argument took place between Gursewak Singh and the petitioner, whereupon the petitioner gave a kick blow on his stomach and Gursewak Singh fell down. The kick blow was given on the stomach of Gursewak Singh but he have received multiple injuries on his head after having fallen down from the bus. Earlier the petitioner was on bail but again arrested on 20.09.2019 and since then he has been in custody and trial would take time to conclude.

On instructions from SI Vakil Singh, learned State counsel states that the injured is bed-ridden and he had received injuries which are dangerous to life.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties. The petitioner has been in custody since 20.09.2019, the trial will take time to conclude and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner behind the bars.

In view of the above, without commenting anything on the merits, lest it should prejudice the case of either side, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
