The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.PC for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to conduct a fair, proper and impartial investigation in FIR No.347 dated 26.09.2018 under Section 376 IPC as well as Sections 4 and 6 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 registered at Police Station South, Sector-34, Chandigarh by constituting a special investigation team (SIT).

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in order to have fair investigation, the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 09.09.2019 (Annexure P-1) to the Superintendent of Police, U.T., Chandigarh, but no action thereof has been taken.

He further states that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the respondent No.2 Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh to consider the limited prayer of the petitioner for fair investigation in the aforesaid F.I.R.

Considering the limited prayer of the petitioner and without issuing notice to the other party, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2 Senior Superintendent of Police, U.T., Chandigarh to look into the contents of representation dated 09.09.2019 (Annexure P-1) and to have a fair investigation in the matter.
