As per pleadings on record, petitioner had been engaged purely on contractual basis as a Meter Reader with a private company namely Sterling Transformers at D.C Rates, Hoshiarpur for purposes of recording meter readings of the consumers on behalf of the respondent-Corporation.

Instant petition has been filed seeking quashing of checking report dated 19.4.2019 (Annexure P-1) as also consequential communications dated 7.1.2020 (Annexure P-4) and 9.1.2020 (Annexure P-5) issued by the respondent-Corporation functionaries and which has led to the disengagement of the petitioner by the private company. Further grievance raised is that on the basis of the impugned communications even an FIR No.31 dated 10.1.2020 under sections 135, 138 of the Electricity Act has been registered against the petitioner.

Quashing of the communications is sought.

Counsel having argued the matter at some length seeks withdrawal of the instant petition.

Prayer is allowed.

Petition is disposed of as withdrawn.
