Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.107, dated 30.07.2016 under Sections 324, 452, 34 IPC, 1860, registered at Police Station Model Town, District Hoshiarpur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in the instant FIR only non-bailable offence is under Section 452 IPC.

The petitioner was declared as proclaimed offender on 06.04.2018. The co-accused of the petitioner have already been acquitted on 01.10.2018. Petitioner has surrendered before the

trial Court on 25.11.2019 and since then he is in custody.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further states that offence is triable by the Magistrate.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Surjeet Singh, states that supplementary challan qua the petitioner is ready to be submitted to the competent Court. Petitioner is in judicial custody since 25.11.2019.

Trial of the case may take some time in its culmination.

In view of the above and without meaning anything on merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to enlarge the petitioner on regular bail subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.

Nothing expressed hereinabove, would be construed to be an expression of any opinion on merits of the case.
