Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner prays that the petitioners be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to file a fresh one on the same cause of action, in case the permits which have been issued to the private respondents, which according to the petitioners are contrary to the provisions of Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 as well as settled principles of law, are made operational.

Dismissed as withdrawn, with the liberty, as prayed for.
