Through this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. prayer has been made for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.231, dated 06.08.2019, registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, at Police Station Kosli, District Rewari.

Allegations against the petitioner are that he got executed a forged registered sale deed in his favour by producing a fictitious lady as seller Rukma before the Sub Registrar, though, seller Rukma had died around 15-20 years back. It has also been mentioned in complaint which culminated into FIR that petitioner is a habitual land grabber.

Heard.

The petitioner is required for custodial interrogation.

Thus, finding no ground to grant the benefit of bail to the petitioner, instant petition stands dismissed.
