Petitioners claim that they have attained majority and married against the wishes of their family members. Apprehending threat to their life and liberty, they have filed the present petition for protection. Petitioners claim to have submitted a representation (Annexure P-5) dated 18.01.2020 in this regard to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar, Punjab.

Notice of motion to the Advocate General, Punjab.

On asking of the Court, Mr. M.S,Nagra, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State. Copy supplied.

Heard. The petitioners have placed on record Aadhar Cards of petitioners No.1 and 2 (Annexures P-1 and P-2) and the petitioners have also produced on record copy of their marriage certificate (Annexure P-3), photographs (Annexure P-4).

During the course of hearing, the petitioners have also made available Matriculation and Secondary School Examination certificate of petitioner No.1 and Copy of Pan Card of petitioner No.2 which are taken on

record and be tagged at appropriate place.

This petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar, Punjab, to look into the representation Annexure P-5 dated 18.01.2020 and ensure that no harm is caused to the petitioners.

However, it is made clear that this order shall not be treated as stamp of the Court about the marriage of the parties and no opinion regarding the validity of the marriage has been expressed.
