Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.3 dated 03.01.2020, registered under Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914 at Police Station Tappa Mandi, District Barnala.

Keeping in view the antecedents of the petitioner as narrated in para No.3 of the order dated 09.01.2020 passed by the Sessions Judge, Barnala, no ground for anticipatory bail is made out. Consequently, the petition stands dismissed.

However, the petitioner would be at liberty to surrender before the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Barnala. In the event of his surrendering and filing a petition for regular bail, the same shall be decided expeditiously preferably within one week strictly in accordance with law.
