Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for direction to respondent Nos.1 and 2 to transfer the investigation to some independent agency in FIR No.97 dated 14.07.2018 under Sections 363, 366-A IPC, registered at Police Station Ding, District Sirsa.

Reply has already been filed by Sh. Aryan Chaudhary, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sirsa, on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 4, wherein it has been stated that Sangeeta, daughter of the petitioner had already been recovered from the area of bus stand Gularia (UP) on 09.02.2019. Thereafter, she was produced before the Illaqa Magistrate, where her statement under Section 164 Cr.P.C. was recorded.

In the said statement, minor girl has stated that “About 7-8 months back, Manish @ Kallu from their village took her to Kashmir

forcibly and thereafter, he took her from Kashmir to City Gola in UP, where

they stayed at Gularia Brick Kiln. Then yesterday night, police approached them who brought her from there”.

In view of the reply filed on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 4, the present petition is rendered infructuous.
