The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 211 dated 20.11.2019, registered under Section 22 of the NDPS Act (Sections 25, 29 of the NDPS Act and Sections 420, 201 of the IPC added later on) at Police Station Boha, District Mansa.

The operative part of the order dated 22.01.2020, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner Davinder Kumar was working at a Medical Store, namely Kansal Medical, Bathinda. He submits that the petitioner has been indicted on the statement of co-accused and further relies upon order dated 17.01.2020 passed in CRM-M No.1982 of 2020 (Adish Jain Versus State of Punjab).

Notice of motion for 27.04.2020.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 22.01.2020, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on telephonic instructions from the Investigating Officer, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 22.01.2020, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
