During the course of the hearing, it has emerged that the FIR No. 6 dated 30.01.2016 under Section 420 IPC, Police Station 'D' Division Amritsar was lodged on the basis of complaint at the instance of Santokh Singh and Narinder Singh with regard to allegations of fraudulent execution of agreement to sale and receipt of amount by the petitioner.

Ms. Kuldeep Kaur, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.2.

After going through the FIR, it indicates that Narinder Singh is also a complainant but he has not been arrayed as respondent in the present petition and is also not a party to the compromise.
