Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.281 dated 03.12.2019 under Sections 379-B/34 IPC Section 411 IPC added later on, registered at Police Station Haibowal, District Police Commissionerate Ludhiana.

The allegations against the petitioner are that on 03.12.2019, when the complainant was in process of hearing a call on his mobile by putting the same on his right ear, a

motorcycle of black colour came from behind with fast speed in

which two Hindu young boys about 26-27 years of age were riding. They snatched mobile phone and fled away on motorcycle.

The complainant could not identify the culprits and read the registration number of the motor cycle. On the next day, the complainant identified the petitioner and his co-accused. A mobile phone has been recovered from the co-accused namely Rupesh Kumar. The motor cycle belongs to the father of the petitioner and the same has been recovered from the petitioner.

Petitioner is in custody since 04.12.2019. Challan has been presented. Learned State counsel, on instructions from H.C. Sanjive Bhagtana, states that charges have not been framed so far. Petitioner is in judicial custody from the date of his arrest.

Trial of the case may take some time in its culmination. At this stage, without meaning anything on merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to enlarge the petitioner on

regular bail subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety

bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.

to be an expression of any opinion on merits of the case.
