Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.PC is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.19 dated 24.01.2019 under Sections 376 and 506 IPC registered at Police Station Women, Yamuna Nagar, though later on charges have been framed under Sections 376(2)(n) and 506 IPC as well as Sections 3 and 4 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012.

At this stage, learned State counsel submits that as against total 12 witnesses cited by the prosecution, 11 witnesses have been examined and the only left out witness is the investigating officer of the case.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press this petition.
