With the sincere efforts of the learned counsel representing the parties, both the parties have arrived at a settlement. The parties are also present in Court alongwith their counsels. They have jointly stated that the husband i.e the petitioner would pay a sum of Rs.25 lacs to the respondent-wife Seema Sharma towards full and final settlement. However, parties have stated that they need to reduce the terms of settlement into writing and present it in the Court.

Since the present petition has been filed against order passed by the Family Court deciding application under Section 24 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, determining maintenance pendente lite, therefore, the present petition is disposed of in terms of the aforesaid settlement. The parties would be free to file an appropriate petition before the Family Court for grant of divorce by way of mutual consent. Parties have also stated that they would withdraw all other cases pending against each

other to put an end to the entire dispute.
