The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 110 dated 25.10.2019, registered under Section 15 of the NDPS Act, 1985 at Police Station Sanaur, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 22.01.2020, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that he has sold the truck in question to one Bir Bhan, who has taken the same on superdari by moving an application before the trial Court, vide order dated 02.07.2020, therefore, the petitioner is not the owner of the said truck.

Learned State counsel has not disputed the factual position, however, submitted that as per allegations in the FIR, petitioner is the registered owner of the truck.

In view of the above, without commenting anything on the

merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 22.01.2020, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
