The grievance of the petitioner is to the effect that Davinder Kumar, respondent No.6 is pressuring and exercising undue influence upon him through his contacts with the higher police officials for payment of the amount pertaining to the property purchased by him. In pursuance of the sale deed, the property has been acquired by Municipal Corporation, Bathinda for raising a park. Respondent No.6 is wrongly alleging the return of the money particularly when the petitioner is neither a party nor a witness to the sale deed in his favour. A representation dated 14.12.2019, Annexure P-6 has already been submitted to respondent No.2.

Without commenting upon the merits of the representation, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the grievance of the petitioner and take appropriate action in accordance with law.
