FIR No.242 dated 23.09.2019, under Sections 307, 34 IPC and Sections 25/54 of the Arms Act, Police Station City Faridkot, has been registered against the petitioner on the basis of statement of Davinder Singh @ Tintu, alleging that on 23.09.2019 at 9.15 p.m., he alongwith his son were proceeding in his car. At about 9.30 p.m., when they parked their car outside their house, then two unknown young boys came on motorcycle and fired shot with intention to kill them. However, the fire shot hit the car and the boys fled away.

It has been stated that the arrest of the petitioner was effected on 12.10.2019 and he has not been named in the FIR.

On the contrary, it is stated by the learned State counsel that subsequently FIR No.269 dated 12.10.2019 under Section 25 of the Arms Act was registered against the petitioner and others. During the investigation of the said case, the petitioner has confessed his involvement in the case. Besides, recovery was effected from him. It has not been

occurrence. The investigation is complete and challan has been presented in the Court. Trial of the case will take sufficient long time. No fruitful purpose will be served to retain the petitioner behind the bars. Similarly placed co-accused Shamsher Singh @ Shera Sekhon and Shamsher Kumar @Shera have been granted regular bail by this Court in CRM-M-757 of 2020 (Shamsher Singh alias Shera Sekhon and another versus State of Punjab) decided on 15.01.2020.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case and after keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, it would be appropriate to direct the petitioner to be released on regular bail. Accordingly, the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing adequate surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Accordingly, the petition is allowed with the aforesaid directions.
