For the reasons stated in the application, which is duly supported by an affidavit, legal heirs of Surinder Singh-respondent No.7 are ordered to be brought on record.

Main case

An application for amendment of the plaint at the fag end of the trial, has been declined by the learned trial Court after appreciating

the pleadings in the original plaint. The plaintiffs want to amend the pleadings under the garb of typographical error which in fact amounts to withdrawal of the material admissions made in the plaint.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that while filing the replication (rejoinder), in fact, the plaintiffs had already stated the correct facts.

If that be so, the Court would examine the same while deciding the suit. At this stage, no ground to permit amendment of the pleadings is made out.

In view of the above, the present revision petition is dismissed.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are disposed of, in view of the abovesaid judgment.
