In the instant criminal writ petition under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India, prayer has been made for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners, at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 11.
