Petitioners claim that they have attained majority and married against the wishes of their family members. Apprehending threat to their life and liberty, they have filed the present petition for protection. Petitioners claim to have submitted a representation (Annexure P-5) dated 13.01.2020 in this regard to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur.

Notice of motion to the Advocate General, Punjab.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Sukhbir Singh, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State. Copy supplied.

Heard. The petitioners have placed on record Aadhar Cards of petitioners No.1 and 2 (Annexures P-1 and P-2) and the petitioners have also produced on record copy of their marriage certificate and photographs (Annexure P-3 and P-4). Today attested photocopy of report book and merit certificate of petitioner No.1 in which date of birth of the petitioner is mentioned as 20.02.2001, have been made available which are taken on record as Mark 'X' and Mark 'Y'.

This petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur, Punjab, to look into the representation (Annexure P-5) dated 13.01.2020 and ensure that no harm is caused to the petitioners.

However, it is made clear that this order shall not be treated as stamp of the Court about the marriage of the parties and no opinion in this regard regarding the validity of the marriage has been expressed.
