Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as a matter of fact the petitioner wishes to examine no further witness in his defence but only wishes to place on record two documents, in the form of a mutation in the revenue record, and a judgment and decree dated 15.06.1995 passed by the Civil Judge/Subordinate Judge in Civil Suit no.273 of 1995, titled as Rajender and others v. Gurdutt.

That being so and accepting the statement made at the bar by learned counsel, to the effect that the suit is still pending at the stage of arguments with the next date of hearing being also at the same stage, the petition is allowed even without issuing notice, to the extent that the aforesaid documents that the petitioner wishes to place on record, shall be allowed to be placed on record, with no comment whatsoever made by this court as to the effect of such documents, if any at all, on the merits of the case of either party, with it further clarified that as

The petition is disposed of as above; however, since this order has been passed without issuing notice to the respondents, if they are aggrieved in any manner thereof, they would be at liberty to file an application seeking a review of this order.
