Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 293 dated 29.12.2016 registered under Sections 120-B, 148, 149, 302, 379-A IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Barauda, District Sonapat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that vide order dated 09.01.2018 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Sonapat regular bail was granted to the petitioner and he was regularly appearing before the learned trial Court. On 18.09.2019, one person, namely, Vijay was allegedly caught while appearing in place of the petitioner, before the trial Court and accordingly FIR No. 537 dated 18.09.2019 under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468 and 471 IPC had been registered at Police Station City Sonapat against the petitioner and Vijay, wherein petitioner has been released on regular bail, vide order dated 04.11.2019, passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Sonapat.

He further states that the petitioner has been in custody for a period of around 4 months.

On the instructions from ASI Sanjay, learned State counsel states that out of 29 prosecution witnesses, only 6 prosecution are yet to be examined and the next date of hearing is 17.03.2020.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the above, without commenting anything on the merits, lest it should prejudice the case of either side, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs. 1,00,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
