Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.494 dated 23.10.2019 under Sections 147, 149, 323, 452, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Tosham, District Bhiwani.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that as per allegations in the FIR, registered at the instance of Dharmbir, he is working as driver and on hearing the noise in the house of Balwan, he went there and saw that Ramkesh (petitioner No.2), Sanjay, Pawan, Gugan Ram and his wife were beating Rati Ram. When the complainant tried to intervene, Sanjay gave spade blow on his head, Ramkesh gave brick and danda blow to Rati Ram and Sanjay gave a leg blow on the abdomen of Savita and others also gave leg and fist blows. When they raised a voice, the accused persons ran away. It is further submitted that in fact, petitioner No.2 has registered an FIR No.493 dated 22.10.2019 under Sections 147, 149, 323, 341, 506 IPC, at Police Station

Tosham, a day prior to registration of the present FIR and there are no specific allegations against the complainant.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and considering the serious allegations levelled in the FIR that all the accused persons not only caused grievous injuries on the head of Rati Ram, but also caused injuries in the abdomen of one Savita wife of Ram Kishan, who was pregnant, I find no ground to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner

In view of the above, present petition is dismissed.
