[1] Prayer in the writ petition is for the issuance of a writ of mandamus for directing the respondents to promote the petitioner to the post of TGT Physical Education.

[2] Learned counsel states that the petitioner fulfills all conditions entitling him for promotion to the post of TGT Physical Education but the claim has not been considered and decided despite legal notice (Annexure P-4) dated 11.09.2018 having been served on the respondents and that in the circumstances, the petitioner would be satisfied, if the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the claim made in the legal notice (Annexure P-4) dated 11.09.2018, in accordance with law in a time bound manner.

[3] Notice of motion to respondent No.2 only.

[4] Mr. Harish Rathee, learned Senior Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.2 and states that he has no objection to the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

[5] Without commenting upon the merits of the claim or the entitlement of the petitioner to the relief claimed, the writ petition is ***disposed of*** by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the claim made in the legal notice (Annexure P-4) dated 11.09.2018, in accordance with law, after taking into account all aspects of the matter, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of 03 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.
