During the course of hearing it has only been agitated that reasonable time has not been granted for the purpose of depositing the amount of compensation. As per the provisions of Section 148 (2) of Negotiable Instruments Act, the amount is required to be deposited within a period of 60 days from the date of the order, or within such further period not exceeding 30 days as may be directed by the Court on sufficient cause being shown by the appellant.

Instant petition is disposed of with a direction that time frame for deposit of the amount shall be governed by the provisions of Section 148 (2) of Negotiable Instruments Act.
