Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in complaint case No.6051 dated 05.07.2013 titled as ***Karamjeet Kaur Versus Malkit Singh and others*** under Sections 323, 341, 354 and 506 read with Section 34 IPC (summoned under Sections 323 and 506 IPC only) filed in the Court of Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Rupnagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that vide order dated 18.09.2017 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Rupnagar, the petitioner was declared proclaimed offender in the aforesaid complaint.

He further states that since the said order dated 18.09.2017 has already been challenged by the petitioner by way of a separate petition, at this stage, he be permitted to withdraw the present petition. However, the

petitioner shall file a regular bail before the trial Court in the aforesaid complaint and the trial Court be directed to decide the bail application preferably within two days.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

It is made clear that in case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within a period of one month from today to seek regular bail, the trial Court shall decide his bail application preferably within two days from the date of filing of such application.
